The **Political Science education minor** (State code: CD) for secondary certification consists of a minimum of **24 credits**.

Teacher candidates for certification in Political Science at the Secondary level must pass the Michigan Test for Teacher Certification (MTTC) in Political Science (Test #010). MTTC content exams should not be taken until 90% of course work in the subject area has been completed.
